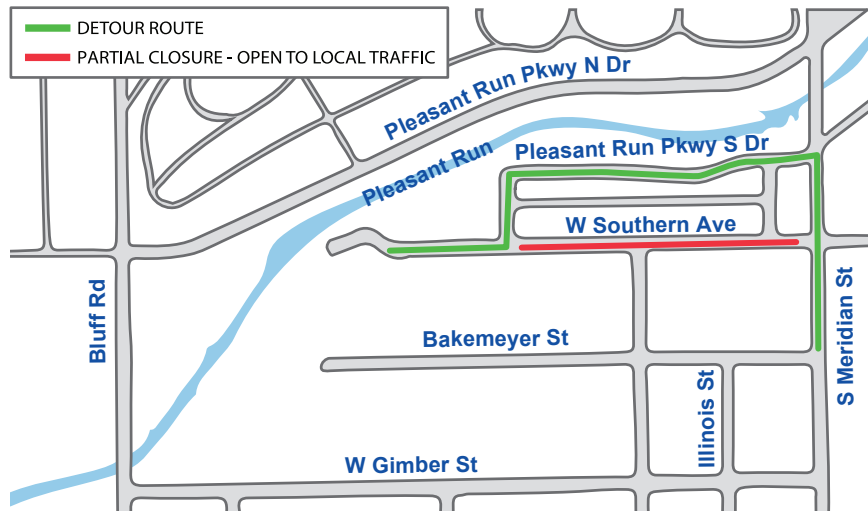


# You may not dig the construction, but we hope you'll DigIndy.

As Citizens Energy Group continues its \$2 billion investment to improve Indianapolis' waterways through the DigIndy Tunnel System, upcoming construction will result in partial lane closures and detours. Beginning July 9, Citizens will begin working on a sewer rehabilitation project near Pleasant Run Creek. This construction will require partially closing the intersection of Capitol Avenue and Southern Avenue for safety reasons. Local access will remain open during this time, but through traffic may be redirected as needed. In addition, tree removal will take place near the point where Southern dead ends (into Pleasant Run Parkway South Drive).



Some residents in the area may experience service disruptions; door tag notifications will be placed at those addresses with details on any outages and/or special instructions.

This phase of construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of October 2018. Although Citizens will return at a later date to complete the remaining construction phases, the site will be restored and access reopened until it is needed again.

Once the 7.4-mile Pleasant Run Tunnel is complete in 2025, it will eliminate more than 95 percent of sewer overflows now occurring from more than 40 points along the creek. Cleaner waterways resulting from the DigIndy Tunnel System will enhance quality of life and drive neighborhood and economic development across our community.
